English Language Ability:

J-1 regulations effective January 5th 2015 require an objective measurement of the English language proficiency, sufficient to participate in the program and to function on a day to day basis.

The department sponsoring the J-1 visitor will need to certify one of the following with supporting documentation:

- Prospective exchange visitor is a citizen or permanent resident of an English speaking Country.
- Prospective exchange visitor has taken a recognized English language test which demonstrates language proficiency (attach score report must be within 2 years).
- Prospective exchange visitor has been interviewed by the CUA department host.
- Prospective exchange visitor has obtained a degree from an educational institution in the United States or another English speaking country. Please attach signed academic transcript.
